



- Some headteachers have expressed concerns that after the salary enhancement for science teachers, instances of absenteeism and focus on personal errands increased.









## 1. Savings and SACCO Investments



- Reinvest in SACCOs use SACCO dividends to purchase more shares in the cooperative.
- Fixed Deposits place savings in fixed deposit accounts for secure and steady interest income.

## 2. Agribusiness Opportunities



- Crop Farming: Venture into high-demand crops such as vegetables, maize, or fruits.
- Livestock Farming: Keep poultry, goats, piggery or fish for a manageable side income.







## 3. Real Estate Ventures



- Rental Properties: Invest in affordable housing units or rooms for rent to generate consistent monthly income.
- Land Purchase: Acquire land for farming, future resale, or leasing to other users.







## 4. Low-Maintenance Investments

- Treasury Bonds and Bills: Invest in government securities for secure, passive income.
- Dividend-Yielding Stocks: Buy shares in companies e.g MTN that offer regular dividends.

- Local Partnerships Collaborate with NGOs or local councils for funded projects like tree planting or waste management.







## Tips for Successful Investments



- Start Small: Avoid overcommitting resources in the initial stages.
- Time Management: Ensure investments do not interfere with teaching responsibilities.

Research Thoroughly: Understand market demands and risks before investing.

Seek Professional Advice: Consult financial experts for tailored investment guidance.

Diversify: Spread investments across different areas to minimize risk.


